

Our nomination/inspection process

- A card will be sent to acknowledge receipt of each nomination received.
- No later than the first week of April, you will be notified of the status of the yearling(s) you have nominated.
- When yearlings are to be inspected, this notice will include a calendar of our inspection schedule for your area.
- At least two days prior to our inspection visit, you will be contacted to schedule an inspection appointment. **PLEASE REMEMBER, in many cases an inspection team will only be in your area on one occasion. Your co-operation in accommodating the time requested will be greatly appreciated.**
- Approximately ten days after our inspection visit, you will be notified in writing of the status of your yearling(s).
- When yearlings do not have acceptable pedigrees for the Canadian Selected Sale, a pedigree printout will be mailed to you along with a contract inviting you to sell these yearlings in the Open sessions of the sale.
- Please telephone us immediately with any changes of location of your yearling(s).
