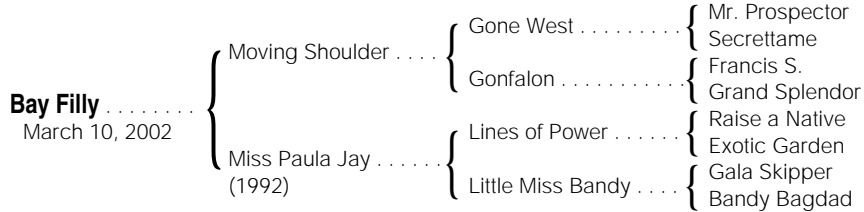

His first foals are 3-year-olds of 2003. Sire of **Movin N Crusin (at 2, 2003, 3rd Manor Downs Thoroughbred Futurity Finals S.)**, **Seymour Moves**, etc.
