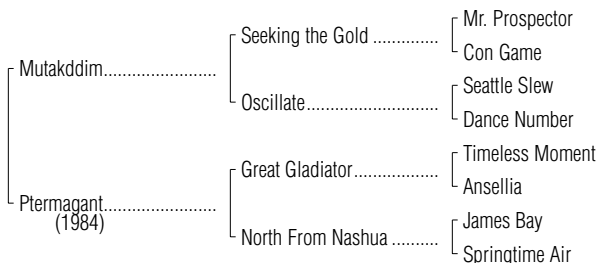

[G3], etc.), Lady Tak [G2] (to 3, 2003, \$516,270).

PTERMAGANT, by Great Gladiator. 7 wins, 3 to 5, \$214,922, Victoriana S. [LR] (WO, \$52,320(CAN)), 2nd La Prevoyante S. [LR] (WO, \$16,200 (CAN)). This is her eighth foal. Her seventh foal is a 2-year-old of 2003.

Palamon. Placed, 2 to 4 in France; placed at 3 in Germany, 3rd Furstenberg-Rennen.

Swapsie. Unplaced in 1 start in N.A./U.S. Dam of 2 winners, including--
