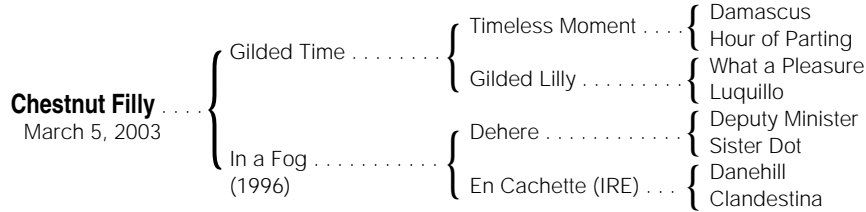

EN CACHETTE (IRE), by Danehill. Winner in England. Dam of 1 other foal to race--
Stone Cold Cat. Placed at 3, 2004, \$10,177.

3rd dam

Clandestina, by Secretariat. Winner at 3 in Ireland, 3rd Gilltown Stud S. Dam of 10 foals to race, 9 winners, including--
DESERT SECRET (IRE). Winner at 2 in England, Royal Lodge S. [G2]; placed at 4, \$10,800 in N.A. Sire.
Bineyah (IRE). Winner at 3 in England, 2nd Aston Upthorpe Yorkshire Oaks [G1]. Producer.
In Camera. Winner at 3 in England, 3rd Tripleprint Derby Trial [G3]. Reviewer. 4 wins at 3 and 4, placed at 6, 2004 in England.
Karasavina (IRE). Unraced. Dam of 3 foals to race, all winners, including--
Krasnaya. 4 wins at 3 and 4, 2004, \$134,910, 2nd Soft Parade S. (CRC, \$7,000), 3rd Golden Or S.-R (CRC, \$4,400).

MY CHARMER, by Poker. 6 wins to 3, \$34,133, Fair Grounds Oaks. Sister to **Keeper's Charm, Sweetie's Charm**. Dam of 6 winners, including--
SEATTLE SLEW. 14 wins in 17 starts, 2 to 4, \$1,208,726, horse of the year, champion colt at 2 and 3, champion handicap horse, Triple Crown, Kentucky Derby-G1, Preakness S.-G1, Belmont S.-G1, etc. Leading sire.
LOMOND. Winner in 4 starts at 2 and 3 in Ireland, Gladness S., etc.; placed at 3 in England, Two Thousand Guineas-G1. Sire.
SEATTLE DANCER. 2 wins in 3 starts at 3 in Ireland, Windfields Farm Gallinule S. [G2], Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. [G2]; placed in 2 starts at 3 in France, 2nd Grand Prix de Paris [G1]. Sire.
ARGOSY. Winner in 2 starts in Ireland, Kilfrush What a Guest S. Sire.
Charming Turn. Winner at 3 and 4, \$30,162, 3rd Minuteman H. Sire.
Clandestina. Black type-placed winner, see above.
Charming Tiara. Unraced. Dam of **Deeds Not Words [G2]** (\$105,145).
Ghashtah. Unraced. Granddam of **Adaala** (at 2, 2004 in Ireland).
