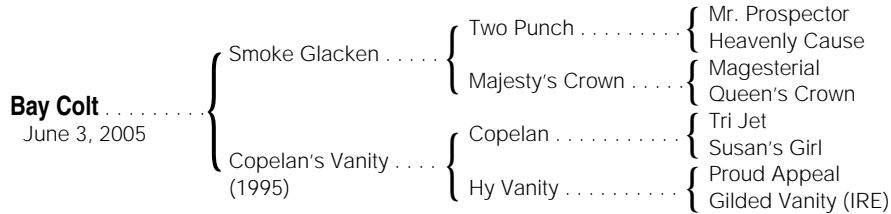

1st dam

COPELAN'S VANITY, by Copelan. 6 wins, 2 to 4, \$127,840. Dam of 2 foals of racing age, including a 2-year-old of 2006, one to race--
Vanity Reigns (g. by King of Kings-IRE). 2 wins at 4, 2006, \$9,132.

2nd dam

Hy Vanity, by Proud Appeal. 6 wins at 3 and 4, \$93,278, 3rd Pan Zareta S. (FG, \$3,476). Dam of 6 foals to race, all winners, including--
Shell Creek. 3 wins at 4 and 5, 2006, \$34,106.
Artwork. Winner one season, \$17,500.

GILDED VANITY (IRE), by Run the Gantlet. 2 wins at 3 in England; winner at 4 in Ireland, Brownstown S.-**G3**; winner at 4 in France. Dam of 3 winners--

Hy Vanity. Black type-placed winner, see above.

Gold Guardian. 3 wins, 3 to 5, \$55,190.

Bonanza Creek. Winner at 3, \$13,060.

4th dam

SUNSET TEMPLE, by *Golden Horus. 3 wins at 3 in Ireland, Cornelscourt S., July S.; placed at 3 in England, 2nd Scarbrough S. Half-sister to **Arctic Lace** (dam of **OATS**, sire; **Regent's Garden**; granddam of **MADAM ASK US, FINE DINING**), **Patcher** (2nd Royal Whip S.-**G3**, etc., sire), ***Frosted Lace, Amablai (GB)** (dam of **BALU, Big Warning**, Red Fantastic, champion in Denmark). Dam of 4 winners, including--

Laurier d'Or. Unplaced in 1 start in Ireland. Dam of--

TAO. 5 wins at 2 and 3 in Germany, Grosser Preis der Steigenberger Hotels [**G3**], Furstenberg-Rennen [**G3**], 2nd Grosser Hertie-Preis von Deutschland [**G2**], Preis Bild Winterfavorit, Oppenheim Rennen, etc.; winner in Denmark, 2nd Dansk Kriterium, champion in Scandinavia.

DORKING. 5 wins at 2 and 4 in Denmark; winner at 3 in Norway, Norwegian St. Leger; winner at 4 in Sweden.

Levirat. Winner at 4 and 6 in Germany, 2nd 167 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen [**G2**], 68 Gerling-Preis [**G2**], etc.

Breeders' Cup nominated.
