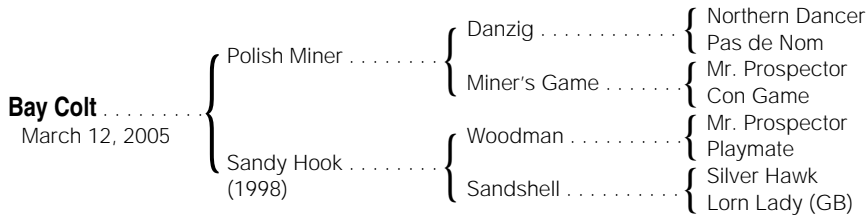

By POLISH MINER (1997), black type-placed winner of 4 races, \$344,646, 2nd Nashua S. [G3], John D. Schapiro Mem. Breeders' Cup H., 3rd Remsen S. [G2], Knickerbocker H. [G2], National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame H. [G2]. Brother to Survivalist [G3] (\$425,170). His first foals are 2-year-olds of 2006. Sire of winner Red Hot Lady (\$21,362).

SANDY HOOK, by Woodman. Winner at 4, \$6,944. This is her first foal.

2nd dam

SANDSHELL, by Silver Hawk. Placed in 2 starts at 2. Sister to LADY IN SILVER. Dam of 4 other foals to race, 2 winners--

Speedy Sonata (f. by Stravinsky). 6 wins, 2 to 4, \$184,372, 2nd Clark County S. [L] (KEE, \$16,890), Kimberlite Pipe S. (KD, \$8,000).

EI Batallon (c. by High Yield). 4 wins, 2 to 4, 2006, \$119,528, 3rd Sportsman's Paradise S. (DED, \$5,500), Seacliff S. (CRC, \$4,400).

LORN LADY (GB), by \*Lorenzaccio. Winner at 3 in Ireland. Half-sister to RIVERSIDE (GB) (dam of RIVERQUEEN-FR, RIVER RIVER, RIVERKING, Kentucky River; granddam of RACHMANINOV [G2]; MALAKIM [G3]; REINE WELLS-IRE, RIVIERE DOREE, Reve de Reine, etc.), \*DOUBLE-U-JAY (sire). Dam of 9 winners, including--

LADY IN SILVER. 3 wins at 2 and 3 in France, highweighted filly at 3 on European Free H., 9 1/2-11 fur., Prix de Diane Hermes-French Oaks [G1], etc.; 3 wins at 4, \$321,396 in N.A., Cardinal H. [L] (CD, \$38,789), 2nd Arlington Million [G1]. Producer. Granddam of QUINTONS GOLD RUSH (3 wins, \$329,835, Coolmore Lexington S. [G2]).

Bright Ivor. 4 wins at 3 and 4, \$65,975, 2nd Fort Lauderdale H. [L], Miami Springs S. [O]. Sire.

Gracious Girl. Winner at 2 in France. Producer. Granddam of New Revolution (3 wins in India, 2nd F. D. Wadia Trophy).

Yarzah. Winner at 3 in France. Dam of Daddy's Darling (in India).

Sherkova. Unraced. Producer. Granddam of NOBEL PRIZE (6 wins in Argentina, Premio Asociacion Argentina de Fomento Equino, etc.; 4 wins in Sweden, champion sprinter, Zawai Baltic Cup; winner in Germany, highweighted handicap horse on German Free H., 132 Jacobs Goldene Peitsche [G2], 3rd Grosser Preis von Berlin [G3]).

Lady Reem. Unplaced in 2 starts in England. Dam of--

IPPON. 11 wins, 2 to 6 in France, Prix Zeddaan, Prix Djebel.

Fully nominated to Maryland Million.

Breeders' Cup nominated.
