Past Performance & Pedigree Analysis

In recent years German bloodlines, and particularly their female families, have been exerting a growing influence on international racing. Among recent examples we can note Danedream, heroine of the 2011 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (gr. I) and 2012 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes (gr. I); the Japanese Dery (gr. I) victor Eishin Flash; the brilliant World Champion Sea the Stars; and Galileo, widely regarded as the world's leading sire, and responsible for the incomparable Frankel.


Kapitale is not only from one of the most important German foundation families, but is also by one of Europe's most exciting young sires, and is herself a group winner and group one performer.

In only eight starts, Kapitale has won twice, capturing the Kolner Herbst-Stutenpreis (gr. III), took third, beaten only two lengths as a three-year-old against older horses in the Premio Lydia Tesio (gr. I), and was fourth on two occasions in North America, beaten just 2³/₄ lengths in the Beverly D. Stakes (gr. I) and Canadian Stakes (gr. II).

Kapitale is by classic winner Dubawi, the outstanding son of the brilliant Dubai Millennium. Dubawi has made a sensational start as a stallion with 45 stakes winners from his first three years at stud, 28 of them group or graded, among them group or grade one scorers Poet's Voice, Makfi, Monterosso, Happy Archer, Luck or Design, Secret Admirer, Dubawi Heights and Waldpark.

Kapitale is also classically-bred on the distaff side of her pedigree as she is halfsister to the outstanding performer Kamsin, a winner of three group one events including the German Derby (gr. I) and the Grosser Preis von Baden (gr. I). Kapitale's dam, Kapitol, also proved her quality in group company with wins in the Preis des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen (gr. III) and Frankfurter Stutenpreis der Mehl Muelhens Stiftung. The classic theme continues in the next generation of the pedigree, as the granddam, Karlshorst, is by Surumu – runway winner of the German Derby, and one of the greatest sires in German racing history – out of Kaisertreue, a daughter of another Germany Derby victor, Luciano, and the classic placed Kaiserzeit. This is the famous "K" family, tracing to Kaiserwurde, ancestress of numerous outstanding runners, including the German Triple Crown winner and leading sire, Konigsstuhl; Kazzia, successful in the English 1,000 Guineas (gr. I) and Oaks (gr. I), and the Flower Bowl Invitational (gr. I); Eastern Anthem, who captured the Dubai Sheema Classic (gr. I); and Kandia, successful in the Aral-Pokal (gr. I), and a close relative to Kapitale's third dam.
