### GO MAGGIE GO

Fully established as one of the leading members of her crop, dual graded winner Go Maggie Go is by one of the great racehorses of modern times, out of a multiple graded stakes producing mare.

A four-length winner on her racecourse debut, Go Maggie Go took on some of the top fillies of her generation in the Gulfstream Park Oaks (gr. II), and emerged with a decisive 2¼ length triumph over grade one winners Off the Tracks, Paola Queen, and Gomo.

Go Maggie Go was similarly dominant in the Black-Eyed Susan Stakes (gr. II), which she captured by 2½ lengths while defeating grade two winners Land Over Sea and Dothraki Queen.

Go Maggie Go also produced an excellent effort in the Kentucky Oaks (gr. I). Squeezed back at the start, she rallied determinedly to miss second by just a neck and a head while finishing ahead of grade one winners Rachel's Valentina, Paola Queen, and Weep No More, and grade two scorers Lewis Bay, Mokat, and Venus Valentine.

Go Maggie Go's sire, Horse of the Year Ghostzapper, was one of the most brilliant runners of the modern era. He set a race-record that still stands while winning the Breeders' Cup Classic (gr. I), and also captured the Metropolitan Handicap (gr. I), Woodward Stakes (gr. I), and Vosburgh Stakes (gr. I). At stud, Ghostzapper has sired such as grade one winners Judy the Beauty, Better Lucky, Contested, Molly Morgan, Morena, Sham Ghost, Stately Victor, Starship Truffles, and Greenzapper. Out of a Broodmare of the Year, and an outstanding sire of fillies, Ghostzapper has all the credentials to become an important broodmare sire. He does already have six stakes winners in that role, all foaled in 2012 or later, including the spectacular grade one winning sprinter Drefong and 2016 two-year-old graded winner Levante Lion.

Go Maggie Go is half-sister to the National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame Stakes (gr. II) scorer, Wallyanna. Go Maggie Go's granddam Marquetry Road is half-sister to stakes winners Castle Park and Hello Mom. In tail-female line, Go Maggie Go traces to a sister to five-time Leading Sire Bull Lea, via noted tap-root mare Oil Princess, and her exceptional daughter Oil Royalty.
