

BACIAMI PICCOLA

Sired by a brilliant sprinter, and from Europe's premier speed sire line, Baciami Piccola is a graded stakes winning miler from a famed female line.

A sharp first time out winner over five furlongs in the May of her two-year-old season, Baciami Piccola earned black-type on her second outing with a third in the Premio Vittorio Crespi. Travelling to France, on her final European outing Baciami Piccola took third against colts in the five furlong Prix des Reves d'Or.

Baciami Piccola's U.S. debut came in the 8½ furlong Florida Oaks (gr. III). Despite making her first start in more than six months and running for the first time at a distance longer than six furlongs, Baciami Piccola closed determinedly to prevail in a 13 horse field that also included graded stakes winners Family Meeting and Gamble's Ghost and stakes winner Ava's Kitten.

Baciami Piccola is by Equiano, an exceptional sprinter who won two renewals of the King's Stand Stakes (gr. I), making him only one of three horses in an 80 year span to twice capture England's most important five furlong event. With his oldest runners only four-year-olds in 2016, Equiano is already sire of ten stakes winners, including, in addition to Baciami Piccola, another U.S. graded scorer in Belvoir Bay, and group winners Medicine Jack, The Tin Man, Fly On the Night, Strath Burn and Dark Reckoning. Equiano's sire Acclamation is another outstanding speed stallion; his offspring also include Dark Angel, Europe's leading sire of fast and precocious racehorses.

Baciami Piccola is the first foal of her dam Lucky Legs, a daughter of Champion racehorse and sire, and important broodmare sire, Danehill Dancer. She is also dam of a two-year-old sister to Baciami Piccola, and a yearling and weanling, both brothers to Baciami Piccola.

Singing Diva, Baciami Piccola's second dam, is a three-quarters sister to Amfortas, winner of the King Edward VII Stakes (gr. II) at Royal Ascot. Singing Diva, is also half-sister to Legend Maker, a group winner who is dam of the English 1,000 Guineas (gr. I) victress Virginia Waters, and of Alexandra of Hales, a group winner who also took second in the Irish Derby (gr. I); granddam of group one winning champion Chachamaidee, of group winner J Wonder, and stakes winners Emperor Claudius and Qertaas; and third dam of stakes winners
