

JAMYSON 'N GINGER

Jamyson 'n Ginger is a two-year-old filly who appears to have unlimited potential. A sensational maiden winner, she is by a Champion Three-Year-Old Colt, who is now an outstanding sire, and is out of a Champion Three-Year-Old Filly.

Jamyson 'n Ginger produced an astounding performance to break her maiden over a mile at Belmont Park on October 9. Although she only took command nearing the three-quarters pole, Jamyson 'n Ginger opened up a remarkable winning margin of 15¼ lengths over runner-up Pray For Bourbon, who had been beaten only 2½ lengths by Frizette Stakes (gr. I) heroine, Yellow Agate, in her only previous start.

The visual impression and the form of this performance was confirmed by Jamyson 'n Ginger's Beyer Speed Figure of 103, the fastest achieved by a two-year-old of either sex in 2016. Chandelier Stakes (gr. I) winner Noted and Quoted has a top Beyer of 80; Spinaway Stakes (gr. I) dead-heaters Sweet Loretta and Pretty City Dancer earned a 75 in that race; Yellow Agate took the Frizette Stakes (gr. I) with a figure of 77; and Dancing Rags captured the Alcibiades Stakes (gr. I) with a 73. In fact no other juvenile filly of 2016 other than Jamyson 'n Ginger has broken 90.

Jamyson 'n Ginger's pedigree is not only one right out of the top draw, but also indicates that she should only improve with time and distance. She is by Bernardini, the only Champion Three-Year-Old son of A.P. Indy. One of North America's most important sires, Bernardini is already responsible for more than 50 stakes winners, including such grade one scorers To Honor And Serve, Alpha, Cavorting, Stay Thirsty, Dame Dorothy, Angela Renee, Rachel's Valentina, A. Z. Warrior, Biondetti, and Greenpointcrusader.

Jamyson 'n Ginger is out of Champion Candian Three-Year-Old Filly Ginger Brew, winner of the Canadian Oaks, Belle Mahone Stakes, Calder Oaks, and Jammed Lovely Stakes; She is also multiple stakes placed, including when second against males in the Queen's Plate. Ginger Brew is also half-sister to near-millionaire Bourbon Bay, winner of the San Luis Obispo Handicap (gr. II), San Marcos Handicap (gr. II), and Cougar II Handicap (gr. III), and two runnings of both the San Juan Capistrano Handicap (gr. II) and San Luis Rey Handicap (gr. II).
