TAP IT ALL

An \$800,000 two-year-old in training purchase, Tap It All is a stakes winning granddaughter of Tapit and is the first foal of a Saratoga stakes winning dam.

Tap It All was the most expensive filly sold at the Fasig-Tipton Gulfstream 2016 two-year-old in training sale. A maiden winner on the turf, she switched to the all-weather to gain a stakes victory when leading throughout to capture the California Oaks. She was also beaten just a head and a nose in the listed Blue Norther Stakes on the turf.

Tap It All is a member of the first crop sired by Tapit's Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (gr. I) winner Tapizar, already sire of black-type winners Tapit It All and Tip Tap Tapizar, graded stakes performers American Pastime, Peppered, and Zartera, and Mr. Crow, whose 109 Beyer Speed figure is the fastest by a three-year-old of 2017.

Tap It All is the first foal of Yawkey Way, a maiden special weight and stakes winner at Saratoga in her first two starts at two. Yawkey Way is also dam of a two-year-old colt by Violence – a \$195,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling – a yearling colt by Hard Spun, a colt foal by Constitution (bred on similar lines to Tap It All, and inbred to this family) and is bred to another Tapit son, Frosted.

Yawkey Way is out of Is Kylie Good, a winning half-sister to stakes winning and graded stakes placed Brushing Bully and to Navajo Pearl, winner of the Princess Elizabeth Stakes, one Canada's most prestigious contests for juvenile fillies.

Is Kylie Good is out of Assombrie, and stakes winner over colts in France at two, and multiple stakes placed in the U.S. In turn, Assombrie is out of stakes winner Anjelicco, and is half-sister to the Arlington-Washington Stakes (gr. I) captor All Fired Up, as well as to Royal Deception, Synformer, and Cox's Angel, a trio of producers from whom descend such as Florida Derby (gr. I) laureate Constitution; Forego Stakes (gr. I) scorer Emcee; Awesome Humor, successful in the Spinaway Stakes (gr. I); the Hopeful Stakes (gr. I) winner Competitive Edge; 2017 graded stakes winner Tricky Escape; and group and graded stakes winners Boynton, Tricky Escape, Wild Syn, and Surfer.
