TOCSET OVER

This young mare is already dam of a stakes winner and grade one performer, and a 2017 graded stakes winning three-year-old. While these are highly-desirable credentials, what makes Tocset Over an even more irresistible prospect is that she is in foal to Tapit.

Tocset Over is dam of three winners from her first four foals. Her first foal, Mexikoma, a son of Birdstone, was a progressive runner who on his last two stakes won the Sunshine Millions Classic, and took third in the Donn Handicap (gr. I) to Mshawish, while defeating Keen Ice – the conqueror of American Pharoah in the Travers Stakes (gr. I) – and millionaire Makefromlucky.

Tocset Over's current three-year-old Overture – a daughter of Congrats – is also a progressive runner. Never out of the first three in seven starts, on her last three outings Overture scored a wire-to-wire victory in the Indiana Oaks (gr. III); took third in the Monmouth Oaks (gr. III), and third in the Charles Town Oaks (gr. III).

Tocset Over is half-sister to stakes winner Doctor Decherd, and to the dam of currently active graded stakes performer Tizzarunner. Her dam, Hidden Pleasure, is a half-sister to graded stakes winner Luftikus, and to stakes winner Diversa, the dam of graded winner Love Theway You are; to stakes winner Sensitivity, the granddam of group winner Lightning Moon and stakes winner Song of My Heart; to graded placed Rare Opportunity, the dam of multiple graded stakes winner Tower of Texas, graded stakes winner Street Sounds, and stakes winner Silver Highlight, and third dam of 2017 stakes winner Duff; to Adoradancer, dam of graded stakes winner Saint Anddan and granddam of stakes winner Ganges; and to Andora Springs, the granddam of stakes winner Continental Divide.

Tocset Over is also dam of a two-year-old colt by Malibu Moon and a filly foal by Bernardini, both three-quarters related to Overture.

Toccet Over sells in foal to Tapit. The dominant sire of recent years, Tapit top the North American Leading Sire list in 2014, 2015, and 2016, setting a new earnings record on each occasion. Tapit has now sired over 100 stakes winners, including Champion Three-Year-Old Filly Untapable; Champion Two-Year-Old Colt Hansen; Champion Two-Year-Old Filly Stardom Bound; Belmont Stakes (gr. I) victors Tonalist and Creator; Frosted, successful in the Metropolitan Handicap (gr. I) and Whitney Stakes (gr. I); as well as such as Tapitsftly, Ring Weekend, Joyful Victory, and Constitution. In 2017, Tapit is sire of 17 stakes winners, including Belmont Stakes (gr. I) captor Tapit, Del Mar Oaks (gr. I) scorer Dream Dancing, and Cupid, successful in the Gold Cup at Santa Anita (gr. I).

The Tapit – Toccet Over foal will be a product of the same Tapit/Deputy Minister cross as Frosted, American Gal, and Tapizar, and graded winners Tin Type Gal and Delightful Joy. Since Tapit is a son of Pulpit, a horse bred on the same cross as Congrats, it will also be close relative to Toccet Over's graded stakes winner Overture.
