MADAM DANCEALOT

A group winner in England at two, and a graded stakes winner in the U.S. at three, Madam Dancealot was beaten inches in a grade one on her most recent outing. As well as being a very accomplished runner, she comes from an outstanding European family.

A precocious two-year-old, Madam Dancealot ran subsequently multiple group two winning colt Mehmas to ¾ length on her racecourse debut. After capturing her maiden, she gained a black-type win taking the Dick Poole Fillies' Stakes (gr. III) by 1¼ lengths from group winner Mystic Dawn, graded stakes winner Grizzel, and Simmie.

In the U.S., Madam Dancealot defeated a field that included the previously undefeated multiple graded stakes winner Sircat Sally and stakes winners Lull, Kenda, and Storm the Hill to capture the San Clemente Handicap (gr. II).

On her most recent start, Madam Dancealot finished fast to miss by just a nose and a neck in the Del Mar Oaks (gr. I), beating Con Te Partiro – a stakes winner at Saratoga and Royal Ascot – and stakes winners Storm the Hill and Kenda.

Madam Dancealot is by the brilliant two-year-old sprinter Sir Prancealot, the Champion Freshman Sire in Great Britain and Ireland for 2016. Sir Prancealot is a son of group one winner Tamayuz, a close relative to the great mare Urban Sea, heroine of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (gr. I) and dam of both Galileo and Sea The Stars. This opens some intriguing possibilities for matings that would duplicate this famous family.

Madam Dancealot's dam, Sisal, is a winning daughter of the breed-shaping Danehill, out of Ship's Twine, a half-sister to two-time group winning and group one placed Alderbrook; to group winner Restructure; to stakes winning and graded stakes placed Royal Strand; and to Native Twine, a stakes winner in Europe and the U.S., and dam of group winner Tahreeb.

The granddam of Ship's Twine, House Tie, is dam of stakes winner Tea House, and ancestress of 15 other stakes winners, among them the Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup (gr. I) victress Danish — a daughter of Danehill, and so closely related to the dam of Madam Dancealot; Dubai World Cup (gr. I) captor African Story; European Champion Rip Van Winkle; group one winning two-year-old Kingsbarns; and the group winning and multiple group one placed sisters Hawkeye and Ace, again both by Danehill, and closely related to the dam of Madam Dancealot.

House Tie is herself a daughter of Champion Irish Two-Year-Old Filly, Mesopotamia, the ancestress of more than 100 stakes winners, including Champion Halling, Japan Cup (gr. I) scorer Alkaased, and other group and grade one winners Just The Judge, Sajhaa, Mastery, Spin Around, Cherokee Rose, Galaxy Libra, Mukhadram, Noordhoek Flyer, Kirklees, San Sebastian, Molesnes, and Balla Cove.
