## **MAJESTIC QUALITY**

The progressive Majestic Quality has a win and two graded stakes placings in her last three outings. She is by a red-hot young sire who excelled as an older horse and is from a classic family.

Majestic Quality made a remarkable debut in stakes competition. Though still a maiden, she finished a fine second to Farrell in the Rachel Alexandra Stakes (gr. II), ahead of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (gr. I) runner-up Valadorna and the multiple graded stakes winning Shane's Girlfriend.

Heading to the west coast, Majestic Quality romped by 6¾ lengths in a Santa Anita maiden special weight. She followed up with a third, beaten only 1½ lengths in the Summertime Oaks (gr. II), ahead of grade one winners It Tiz Well and Noted and Quoted. Most recently, Majestic Quality took third, again only 1½ lengths shy of victory in the Indiana Oaks (gr. III).

Majestic Quality is by the brilliant Quality Road. At three, Quality Road captured three graded stakes, including the Florida Derby (gr. I), and set track records at 6½ and nine furlongs. Returning at four, Quality Road added a track-record breaking victory in the Donn Handicap (gr. I), which he took by 12¾ lengths, and wins in the Woodward Stakes (gr. I) and Metropolitan Handicap (gr. I).

The Leading Freshman Sire of 2015, Quality Road is off to a tremendous start as a stallion, and is already sire of 19 stakes winners from his first three crops, including Abel Tasman, winner of four grade one events, including the Kentucky Oaks (gr. I), Coaching Club American Oaks (gr. I), and Acorn Stakes (gr. I); Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (gr. I) scorer Hootenanny; other grade one winners Illuminant and Klimt; and grade two winners Salty, High Ridge Road, Blofeld, and Frank Conversation.

Majestic Quality is half-sister to Diski Dance, an 11-time winner who also took second in the Toboggan Stakes (gr. III). Her dam, She Nuit All, is a half-sister to the exceptional filly Octave, successful in the Coaching Club American Oaks (gr. I),

Mother Goose Stakes (gr. I), and Adirondack Stakes (gr. II), and six-times grade one placed, including second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (gr. I) and third in the Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I). She Nuit All is also three-quarters sister to Belle Cherie, winner of four graded stakes events, including the Top Flight Handicap (gr. II), and dam of stakes winning and graded placed Beaux Choix (by Quality Road's sire, Elusive Quality, and closely related to Majestic Quality) and stakes winner Last Best Place (by Gone West, the grandsire of Quality Road).

Majestic Quality's second dam, Belle Nuit, is a stakes winning half-sister to Ms. Eloise, successful in the Top Flight Handicap (gr. I) and Shuvee Handicap (gr. I), and dam of graded winner Bibury Court and stakes winner Princess Eloise; granddam of stakes winners Don Dulce, Sweet Relish, and Kanturk Kid; and third dam of stakes winner Major Marvel.

A progressive filly who has finished close up in graded stakes on each of her last two starts, Majestic Quality has clear black-type winning potential, and she also has a pedigree which carries serious residual value.
