



# Fasig-Tipton

Dear Consignors:

The Calder Sale is scheduled for Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 11:00 am at the Calder Race Course, NW 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 210<sup>th</sup> Street, Miami Garden, Florida:

**STABLING:** Stalls will be available Monday, February 15<sup>th</sup>. Consignors must have their horses on the grounds no later than February 20<sup>th</sup>. Should you require stalls prior to February 15<sup>th</sup>, please contact Daren English at 859.312.7801.

**NOTE:** Please contact Daren English if you wish to bring a pony with your consignment and we will do our best to accommodate you. Peter Penny and Daren English will be in our Calder office beginning Monday, February 15<sup>th</sup> to assist you with your stabling and sale needs throughout the sale.

**UNDER TACK SHOW:** There will be ONE showing under tack for consignors at Calder on Friday, February 26 beginning at 10:00 am at Calder Race Course's main track. The order of show will be Consignor preference and the breezes will be timed electronically and videotaped.

**PLEASE NOTE: Friday, February 26 is the only day the video team will be taping sales horses on the track.**

**TURF COURSE:** The turf course will be available for electronically timed and videotaped breezes (limited to 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile) immediately following the under tack show on Friday, February 26. The horse must have galloped on the turf to be allowed to breeze on the turf. The turf course will be available on Tuesday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> for galloping.

**STABLE EQUIPMENT:** There will be no stable equipment supplied. All tubs, buckets, rakes, forks, screens, etc. are the responsibility of the consignors.

**MANURE PITS:** NO HAY/STRAW STORAGE will be permitted in these areas. THESE BINS ARE FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF DISPOSAL OF USED BEDDING MATERIAL AND NOT FOR THE STORAGE OF HAY OR STRAW OR ANYTHING ELSE.

**FEED/STRAW/SUPPLIES:** Below please find the names of four reputable feed and straw suppliers in the South Florida/Miami area. Consignors are urged to make arrangements with the vendor of their choice prior to shipping into Calder.

**SLEEPING ROOMS:** Beds, sheets, pillows and blankets for the stable help are not provided. Those consignors who wish to sleep stable help on the grounds should call beforehand so that space can be allotted.

**STALL CARDS:** The Sales Company does not supply stall cards. The standard stall card size is 28" x 44". We have had satisfactory service from the following supplier and recommend you contact them well in advance if you require stall cards.

**TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:** ALL HORSES will be monitored each day on both the main track and the training track. All horses must wear a numbered saddle cloth and the rider or trainer must notify sales personnel what the horse will be doing.

**USE OF RACE TRACK:** Unless otherwise directed by the management of Calder Race Course, horses will have the use of the race tracks during normal training hours. NO HORSE MAY BREEZE ON THE TRAINING TRACK.

**LICENSING:** EACH MEMBER OF YOUR STAFF **MUST** APPLY AND BE GRANTED A BADGE BY CALDER RACE COURSE.

PLEASE SUBMIT THE ENCLOSED LICENSING FORM IN ADVANCE of your arrival at Calder. Calder Race Course management asks for your cooperation in order to alleviate the delays you will experience if everyone applies as they arrive on the sale grounds.

**BODY PROTECTORS/  
FLAK JACKETS:**

**ALL RIDERS GOING TO THE MAIN AND TRAINING TRACKS MUST WEAR BODY PROTECTORS AND HELMETS.**

**SADDLE CLOTHS AND  
HALTER TAGS:**

Saddle cloths and halter tags should be picked up at the Sales Office upon arrival. Care should be taken to see that they are returned to the Sales Company as you will be charged for those NOT returned.

**STATE REGULATIONS  
ON MEDICATION:**

STATE MEDICATION RULES AT THOROUGHBRED SALES IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA ARE AS FOLLOWS:

In specific circumstances, medications may be administered by licensed veterinarians to sales horses for therapeutic reasons and/or when necessary for the treatment or prevention of illness or injury. Any medication given within 72 hours of the start of the sales session, or within 24 hours of the start of any Under Tack Show, whichever period is longer, in which the horse is to perform or is to be offered for sale, must be documented and reported to the Sales Company in writing in compliance with Florida Statutes, Title XXXIII, Chapter 535.01-535.14. Prospective purchasers are entitled to review this documentation, which will be maintained in the repository. Purchasers may request a post-sale blood test within 24 hours of the time of sale AND prior to taking physical possession of the horse in question. The cost of testing is the sole responsibility of the purchaser. For further information, please contact the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, a veterinarian licensed in the state of Florida, and/or the Sales Company. The Florida Medication Regulations are separate from and in addition to the Sales Company's Medication Policy. Consignors must comply with both the Fasig-Tipton Company, Inc. Medication Policy and the Florida Statute.

Additional Medication Rules and Restrictions are as follows:

Medications may only be administered at or below manufacturers recommended dosages. The medication policy and testing procedures will be administered according to the guidelines of the sales company subject to state regulations.

**RESTRICTIONS:**

1. No more than two (2) non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDS) may be administered.
2. No more than one (1) cortico-steroid may be administered.
3. No bronchodilators, including but not limited to Clenbuterol and Albuterol, may be administered within 72 hours of an under tack show or sales session in which the horse is entered.

4. No exogenous anabolic steroids or their esters are to be administered within 45 days of sale.
5. The following medications may **NOT** be administered on the sales grounds.
  - ~ all substances classified as either Class I or Class II by the Association of Racing Commissioners International (ARCI)
  - ~ Furosemide (Salix or Lasix)
  - ~ Procaine Penicillin

**PROHIBITED PRACTICES:**

The following are not permitted on the sales grounds:

- **Extracorporeal Shock Wave Therapy or Radial Pulse Wave Therapy;**
- **Acupuncture and/or Electro-Stimulation** with the intent of altering laryngeal function;
- **Electrical devices** designed or used to increase the speed of a horse;
- Any invasive practice which intentionally conceals a material defect or chronic lameness.

**Internal Blister or other injections** to the knee intended to have the effect of concealing the true conformation of the horse is not permitted at any time.

**HORSESHOES:**

A horse at a two-year-old in training sale may not train with front shoes that have toe grabs which exceed 2mm, or bends, turn-downs, stickers, jar caulks or any other traction device. Turn-downs of more than ¼" will not be permitted on hind shoes.

**JCC REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES:**

If you have not submitted the Jockey Club Certificate of Registration to the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky office, please send the certificate immediately to Fasig-Tipton Kentucky, PO Box 13610, Lexington, KY 40583-9961. **All Jockey Club Certificates are required to be in our Kentucky office by February 10, 2010.** A charge of \$50 per horse will be assessed if the Jockey Club registration certificate is received after this date.

**NAMES:**

Name authorization slips for all named horses must be attached to the Jockey Club Certificate of Registration.

**E.I.A. (COGGINS) CERTIFICATE:**

Each sales horse must have an individual form dated within six (6) months of the sale (no earlier than September 4<sup>th</sup>) stating that the horse in question has tested negative to the E.I.A. or AGID test. **All Coggins Certificates are required to be in our Kentucky office by February 10, 2010.** A \$50 charge will be assessed after this date. The Form must identify the horse fully and properly by sire/dam, or dam, sex, color and age. Each form must include the veterinarian's signature and results. PLEASE DO NOT USE BARN NAMES OR NICKNAMES. PLEASE SEND EITHER THE ORIGINAL OR A COPY OF THE COGGINS TO THE KENTUCKY OFFICE BY THIS DATE. HORSES DO NEED TO TRAVEL WITH A COGGINS.

## HEALTH

### CERTIFICATES:

The Stable Gate at Calder WILL NOT PERMIT ANY HORSE TO ENTER THE GROUNDS unless it is accompanied by a health certificate dated within 30 days of arrival at Calder.

### EQUINE VIRAL

#### ARTERITIS (EVA):

ALL SALES HORSES MUST HAVE an EVA Test on file dated within ninety (90) days of sale (dated after December 4<sup>th</sup>). Although this is not a warranted condition to buyers, any horse which tests positive will be listed as such at the sales office.

**All EVA Certificates are required to be in our Kentucky office by February 10, 2010.**

Even though there are changes in requirements from various European countries, we recommend consignors have ALL SALES HORSES TESTED FOR EVA. SEE ATTACHED DEADLINE LETTER.

### EQUINE HERPES

#### VIRUS (EHV-1):

The following is applicable to all horses, including ponies:

“Pre-existing entry health requirements remain in effect. Horses originating from facilities other than those having similar requirements (Gulfstream and Palm Meadows) must arrive with Proof of Vaccination for EHV-1 (no less than 14 days, no greater than 90 days), and Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with EHV-1 specific affidavit and proof of negative Coggins Test.”

All horses entering Calder are required to be accompanied by and listed on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that is signed and dated within 72 hours of arrival by a licensed veterinarian. Each horse listed on the CVI **could not have originated from, nor been stabled on, a premises which has had EHV-1 diagnosed during the previous 30-day period.**

### WORKERS COMPENSATION

#### INSURANCE:

**All Consignors MUST have a Certificate of Proof of Workers Compensation Insurance on file with Calder Race Track in order to be admitted to the race track grounds. Please see attached letter in this regard.**

#### PRIVATE SALES:

Private sales can be completed only on horses that have been THROUGH the sales ring and are not sold.

#### NOTICE:

**RULE FOR ALL AREAS OF CALDER RACE COURSE...NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE RACE TRACK GROUNDS AT ANY TIME.**
