



DEADLINES

TO: CONSIGNORS OF THE 2010 TEXAS SUMMER YEARLING SALE; AUGUST 30, 2010.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: AUGUST 1, 2010 : Registration papers for all yearlings should be on file in the **Texas** office by this date. A charge of **\$100** per horse will be assessed if the registration certificate is received after this date.

COGGINS: AUGUST 1, 2010: Each horse in the sale must have an individual form dated **within SIX (6) months** of the sale (**no earlier than FEBRUARY 1, 2010**) stating that the horse in question has tested negative to the **E.I.A. or AGID** test. A charge of **\$50** per horse will be assessed after this date. The form must identify the horse fully and properly by sire/dam, or dam, sex, color and age. Each form must include the veterinarian's signature and results. **DO NOT USE BARN NAMES OR NICKNAMES. Copy of Coggins must be filed with this office prior to this date.**

***EVA: AUGUST 1, 2010: Are REQUIRED** They should be dated within 90 days of the sale (dated after April 30, 2010).

ALL HORSES, entering the stable area must be accompanied by a **HEALTH CERTIFICATE** dated within 10 days of date of sale. **Please bring the certificate to the office immediately upon arrival.**

***A NEGATIVE cELISA Piroplasmosis test is now REQUIRED to enter sales grounds. The result and accession number MUST be listed on the Health Certificate.**

NAME CARDS: Name authorization cards for all named horses must be attached to the Certificate of Registration.

BREEDERS CUP AND STATE BRED CERTIFICATES: Breeders Cup certificate and State Bred Certificate should be sent to our office if not attached to the Jockey Club Certificate. This needs to be attached for the new owner.
