

Conditions of Sale and Ownership Transparency

Dear Consignors:

In order to comply with the Recommendations of the Sales Integrity Task Force, Fasig-Tipton has modified its Conditions of Sale to provide for Transparency in Ownership. Condition Twentieth sets forth in detail Fasig-Tipton's recommendations and requirements for ownership transparency.

Condition Twentieth creates an Ownership Registry in which consignors and sellers may submit an accurate Statement of Ownership of horses to the Fasig-Tipton Sales Office. Buyers who meet the requirements of the Condition (including an agreement to keep the ownership information confidential) may then review the ownership information on a particular horse at the Sales Office. Participation in the Ownership Registry is not mandatory, but encouraged. Accordingly, should you decide to participate, enclosed is a Statement of Ownership form to remit to the Sales Office.

Regardless of whether you choose to participate in the Ownership Registry, Condition Twentieth does require disclosure of a change of ownership of a horse (but not the identity of the new owner) once it is on the sales grounds. A change of ownership of ten percent or less is not deemed to be material and is therefore not a change of ownership. Change of Ownership forms will be available at the Sales Office.
